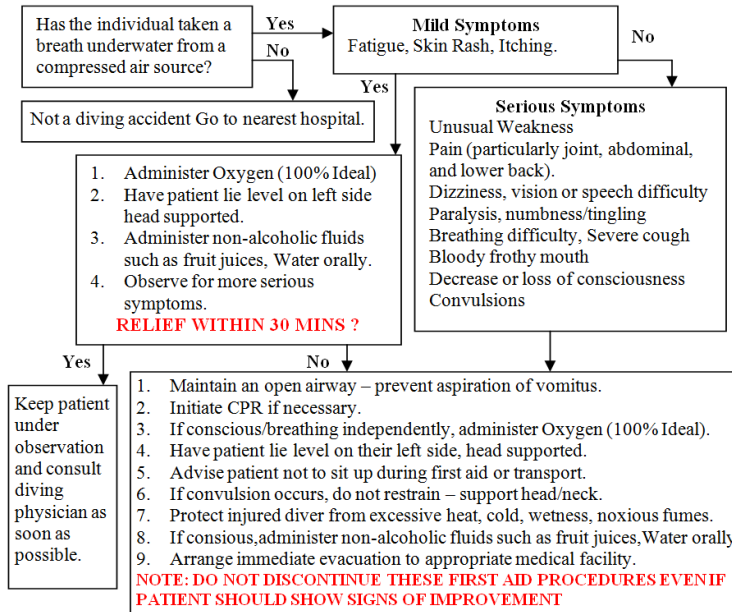

Emergency Procedures

Missing Diver

- Determine last seen/known location
- Assign spotters to watch last location
- Send out snorkelers to last location
- Assign diver team to begin initial search
- Contact Emergency Services

Venomous wounds

- Remove spines with forceps
- Soak area with hot water (110F to 120F)
- Keep affected limb below heart level

Jellyfish Stings

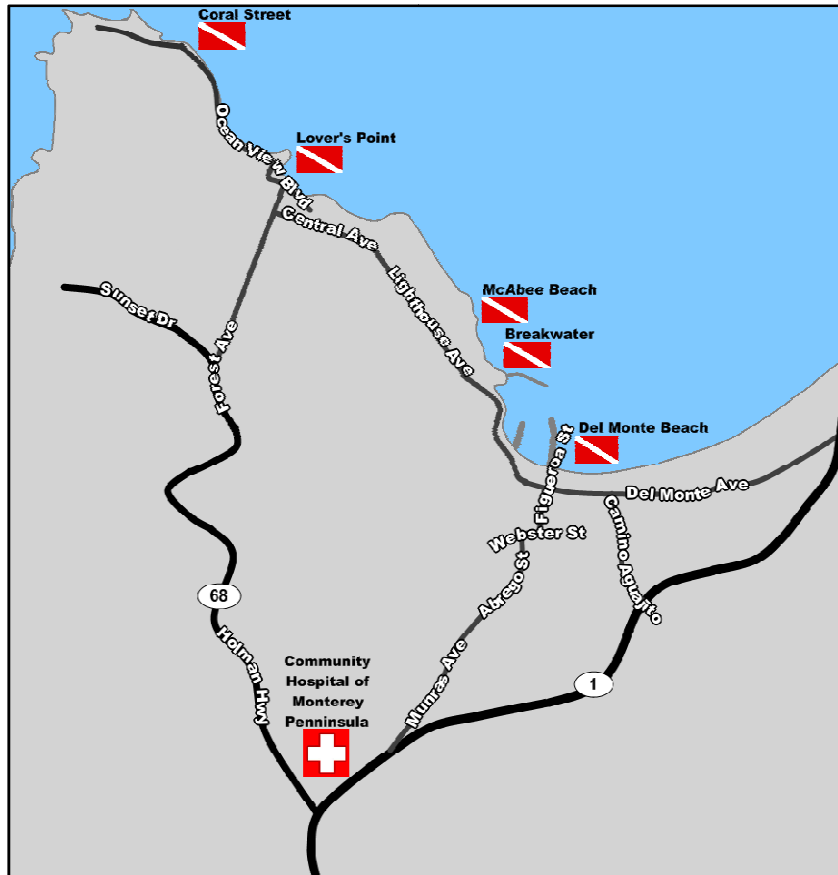
- Remove tentacles with forceps
- Irrigate area with seawater (not fresh)
- Apply vinegar, treat for pain

Heat Exhaustion/Stroke

- Remove exposure suit
- If sweating, move to cool area, offer water
- If not, immerse in cool water or apply cool wet towels. Contact Emergency Services.

From Del Monte

- Turn left on Del Monte
- Turn right at Camino Aguajito
- Turn right to merge onto CA-1 South
- Take exit 399A for CA-68 towards Pacific Grove
- Hospital is immediately on the right

From Breakwater/McAbee

- Turn left on Lighthouse
- Turn right at Figueroa
- Turn right at Webster
- Turn left at Abrego
- Continue on Munras
- Take ramp, merge onto CA-1 South
- Take exit 399A for CA-68 towards Pacific Grove
- Hospital is immediately on the right

From Coral Street/Lover's

- Head south on Forest
- Continue on CA-68/Holman Hwy
- Make a U turn at Aguajito
- Hospital is on the right immediately after passing CA-1 overpass
